To whom it may concern,

This letter is to provide clarification that the insect repellent in Sunsect, (active ingredient DEET), has been proven to repel against the mosquitos (*Aedes albopictus* and *Aedes aegypti*) that may carry the Zika Virus, along with West Nile, Chikungunya, Dengue fever, and other mosquito-borne illnesses across the globe. In addition, also proven effective repelling ticks that may carry Lyme disease.

All have been approved by the EPA and submitted on our master label. In addition to providing protection against insects, Sunsect also provides sun protection. Sunsect is unique in that it is the only product to combine DEET + Sunscreen as a lotion. Created to solve the problem of ineffectiveness by using two separate products, Sunsect was originally tested in the Walter Reed Army Institute (WRAIR). Sunsect was approved for Military use and issued NSN# on our original 2 products. (.3 oz foil packs, 2 oz tubes).
